Sprinkler, Standpipe and Fire Pump Inspection and Testing as per NFPA Standards

All buildings in New York State must comply with NFPA 25 standards for sprinkler, standpipe and fire pump inspection, testing and maintenance.

In recent months, Local Fire Marshals and FDNY inspectors have been strictly enforcing NFPA 25

Required Testing by Master Fire Suppression Piping Contractors (MFSPC):

If you only hold a Certificate of Fitness:

- Quarterly Testing
- Semi-Annual Testing
- Annual Testing
- 5 Year, 10 Year, 20 Year Interval Required

If you hold a Certificate of Fitness and Engineer License:

- Annual Testing
- 5 Year, 10 Year, 20 Year Interval Required

Please note that fire Pumps are no longer required to be operated weekly. The new NFPA 25, (2011) Edition, recently adopted by the FDNY, require Fire Pumps to be operated monthly.



Log Books containing detailed records of your inspections, testing and maintenance are a key aspect of compliance. Total Fire Protection will provide you with official Log Books that prove your building adheres to the standards set out by NFPA 25.
